The first version of the new start page has been released a while ago. The new start page in Visma EasyCruit will now undergo some changes based on the feedback we have received from you. Both the vacancy list and calendar has seen some overhaul to make sure it works according to your needs. These changes will be released in phases.

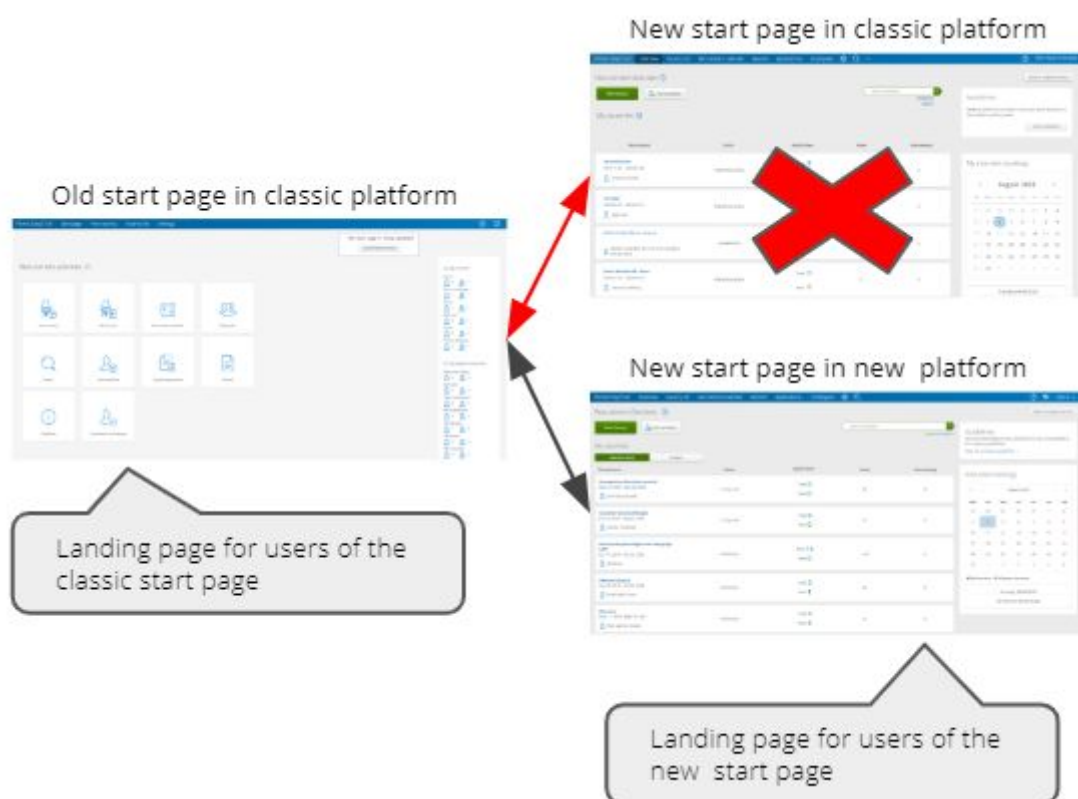
Please make sure you familiarize yourself with the changes and the phases so you can make the necessary preparations to inform your users and update internal client specific documentation.

Phased approach

To ensure a smooth transition process and to give you time to prepare we have prepared a phased approach to the upcoming changes.

Phase 1 - will be released +/- 26 August 2020

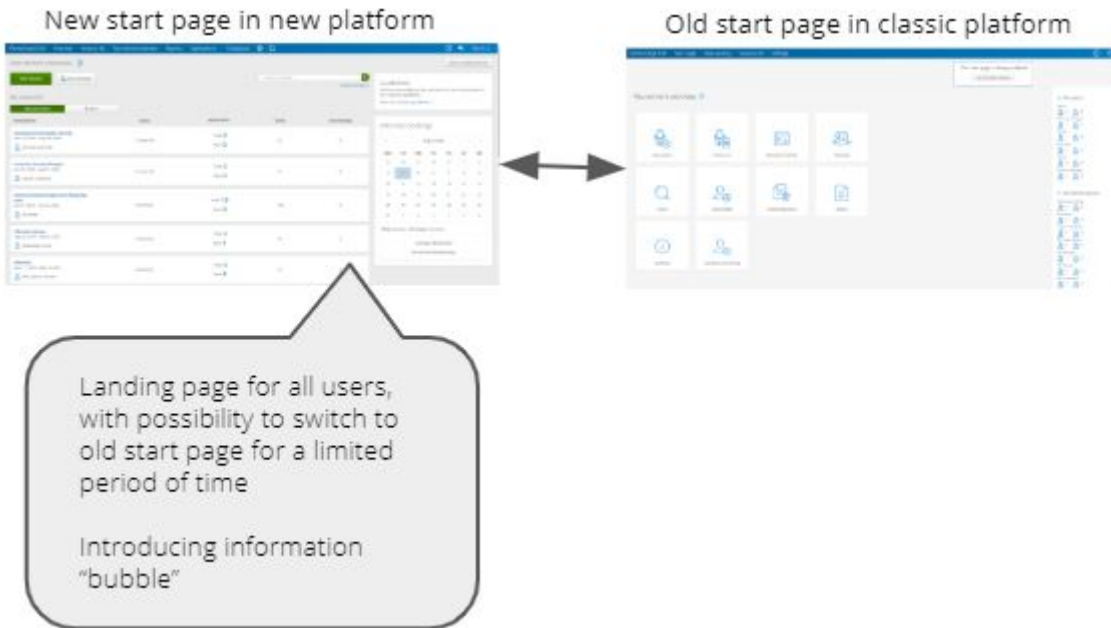
Redirect to the new start page for users choosing to see the new start page remains in place.



We will be making some technical changes as well as adding some visual changes. In the next chapter you will find more information about these changes.

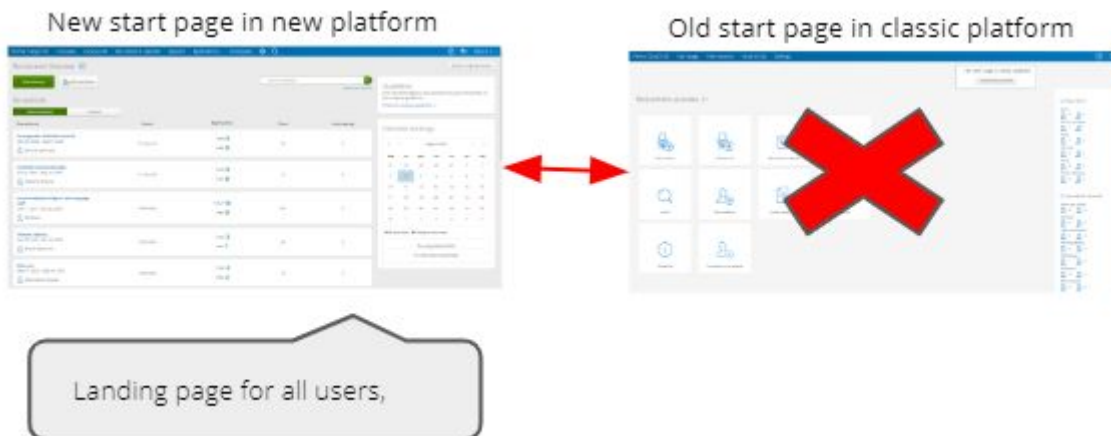
Phase 2 - will be released +/- 16 September 2020

Redirect to the new start page for all users, with the possibility to go back to the classic start page.



Phase 3 - will be released +/- 31 October 2020

Redirect to the new start page for all users. The classic start page will be permanently removed.

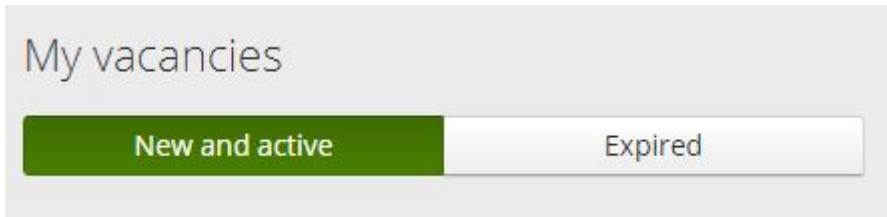


Starting at phase 2 an information notification bubble will be added to the new start page. The goal of this bubble is to prepare users for the upcoming changes. Many clients create their own documentation and we want to give you enough time to update these and provide necessary information to your users.


Changes made to the Start page

My vacancies

The vacancy section has been extended to include up to 10 vacancies now. In addition to this, you will also be able to swap between active and expired vacancies.



The vacancies shown will now prioritise your own ones. Only if you have less than 10 vacancies will it show vacancies from other users. As per before, you can access all vacancies in the vacancy list. Vacancies are now ordered according to the publication period as well rather than last activity.
